on Hillview Ave.**

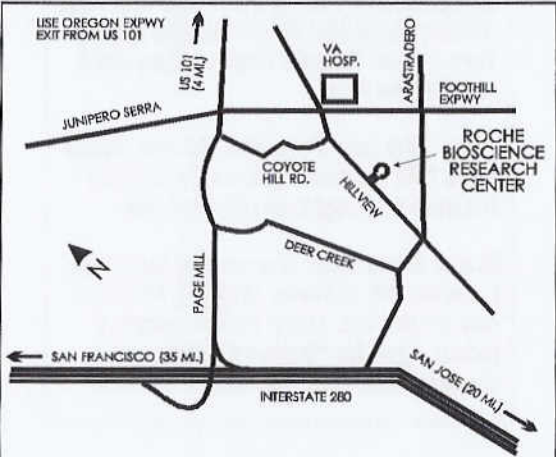
**From 280 take Page Mill Rd exit. From

Course Description: This basic to advanced course will highlight the vulnerable cornea. It will include anatomy and physiology of the cornea, describe medical management of corneal conditions and sight-threatening drug toxicities. Drug resistant organisms will be defined and at-risk populations identified. Recent surgical innovations / techniques including the artificial cornea will be discussed.

Objectives: At the completion of this course the participant should be able to:

- I. Describe the corneal layers and differentiate bacterial from viral conjunctivitis.
- II. Discuss at least one corneal condition and its medical management.
- III. Name a toxic drug and its effect on the cornea
- IV. Explain a newer transplant technique and how it improves surgical outcome.
- V. Identify at-risk populations for drug resistant organisms.
